### TOPIC: THE ANSON AND THE PROBATION SYSTEM

**Date:** 5th May 2019 at Hobart Town Hall, Macquarie Street, Hobart.

The HMS *Anson* arrived in Hobart as a male convict transport in 1844 and was subsequently refitted as a probation station for female convicts. It was then towed to New Town Bay and shortly after to Prince of Wales Bay, Risdon, near Hobart, where it was moored.

## MAY 1 2019 – 10 AM TO 4 PM - BELLERIVE HERITAGE EVENT

The 2019 Australian Heritage Festival is happening throughout May. Events across Australia are being held at historic buildings, landmarks and shipwreck and sacred sites.

The theme is '**This place matters**'.

Four organisations in three historic buildings in Bellerive are opening their doors to the public on Wednesday, **May 1**, to offer a unique historical experience.

- The Hobart branch of the **Tasmanian Family History Society** at 19 Cambridge Road, Bellerive - you can examine their resources and find out how they can assist in discovering your family history.
- **Sound Preservation Association of Tasmania** - a collection of sounds from the past and the equipment on which those sounds can be reproduced. You can listen to recordings of Tasmanian voices, Tasmanian compositions and Tasmanian events and see a display of Tasmanian audio equipment and memorabilia.
- **Bellerive Historical Society** at 17 Cambridge Road, Bellerive - an opportunity to learn about the history of the Bellerive area and arm yourself with a map of the historic houses in the area.
- **Ferryman's House** - a private museum in a turn-of-the century building at 2a Victoria Esplanade, full to the gunwales of Bellerive and Ferry memorabilia.

Entry is free, there are no bookings required and hours are from 10am until 4pm. All the venues are within easy walking distance.
