## COLONIAL TREASURES TO BE FREELY AVAILABLE

The Tasmanian community will benefit from the digitisation of Tasmanian colonial documents held by the Parliament of Tasmania Library, following a successful grant from the Tasmanian Community Fund (TCF) to the Tasmanian Family History Society (TFHS).

These colonial documents, rich in detail, will be digitised and then made freely available to all Tasmanians to access online for family study and research purposes.

President of the Legislative Council and Chair of the Project Team, the Hon. Jim Wilkinson, said the information contained in the digitised documents would be an important educational resource not only for Tasmanian Parliament and the TFHS, but also the entire community by fostering and encouraging an interest in Tasmanian History.
